Biltmore House & Gardens

This winding three-mile drive is part of Frederick Law Olmsted's landscape design, creating separation from the busy world outside Biltmore's gates, and building anticipation as you approach the spectacular house.

Once arriving at Biltmore House, your admission includes a self-guided visit through grand rooms, family bedrooms, servants' areas, and recreational spaces.

For a closer look, consider our Behind-the-Scenes Guided Tours taking you places most guests never see:

- *Architect's Tour* focuses on design and construction offering awesome views from balconies and rooftops
- *Butler's Tour* showcases the mechanical systems providing heat, hot water, and communication plus the work of servants
- *Vanderbilt Family & Friends Tour* provides fascinating stories about the people who visited Biltmore illustrated with vintage clothing and accessories

Savor lunch at the historic Stable Café next to Biltmore House, where you dine where George Vanderbilt's prized horses once lived! Then continue your exploration through acres of exquisite gardens designed by Frederick Law Olmsted, the father of American landscape architecture. From the shady confines of the Library Terrace to the open views of the Bass Pond, your admission includes formal and informal gardens—each with its own history to share.
