QEP Summary

The WSCC Quality Enhancement Plan is titled [ADVISE TO RISE \(Opens in new window\)](#). It focuses on transforming the college's advising community through the introduction and use of new developmental and intrusive/proactive advising practices. Our QEP will strive to increase student success by improving positive relationships between advisors and students, promoting student involvement in the advising process, becoming connected and engaged with campus resources, and finally by instilling and fostering a sense of individual responsibility in students. These changes will be fostered and encouraged by the following four actions:

- 1) Master Advising Course (Advising 101) for all cohort students. The Advising 101 course will have an advisor that guides each individual student during their enrollment at WSCC.
- 2) The use of an Advising Syllabus that clearly outlines advisor and student responsibilities and expectations.
- 3) Expansion of the Student Success Center, which will allow specific assigned advisors to work with the QEP cohort students.
- 4) Professional Development Training for all advisors.

When the QEP begins, the plan involves creating a cohort (a small group of students) consisting of General Studies majors who are required to take the EDUC 1030 (College Experience) course. These students will participate in the Advising 101 course and use the advising syllabus. An advising team, chosen from across the college, will work with the students and assess the course based on the extent the students in the cohort complete the pre-advising assignments.

The plan coordinates the college's advising communities, early warning programs, and new technologies with an emphasis on increasing the student's own involvement in educational planning and engaging every student in the advising process. The most successful practices from this Quality Enhancement Plan will be added later to advising practices at all WSCC campus locations.
