- Academic essay (limit 1, from 8 to 15 double-spaced pages)

Applicants are welcome to submit in multiple categories at once. Please submit your work in one document, including a cover letter and any labels to differentiate category. We prefer file types .doc, .docx, or .rtf.

Your cover letter should include your name, address, phone number, e-mail address, title(s) of your submission(s), and a short bio.

We do accept simultaneous submissions, but please notify us promptly if your submitted work is accepted elsewhere.

If you would like to be considered for publication, please send an electronic version of your submission to [kenneth.hill@ws.edu](mailto:kenneth.hill@ws.edu) by **April 1, 2024**. Please make the subject line of your email include your last name and the genre(s) of your submission(s). Submissions will be reviewed by our editorial board and can take up to three months to be thoroughly processed.
