Community Outreach and Recruitment:

- **Noche Bilingüe** (1.5 hours | 1-2 times/year) – Campus Tour, Activity, Information in English and/or Spanish.
- **Connect Visits** (15 min-1.5 hours | individually arranged) – Hear the “real” college experience from students and connect to RHiTA planning resources. All ages. English and/or Spanish.
- **Juntos. Together. Exploration.** (2.5-3 hours, offered in a series | individually arranged) – Walk through goal setting, an exploration of institutions / programs of study, and planning resources. Students will leave with a plan in-hand. For 10th, 11th, and 12th graders. English and/or Spanish.
- **STEM Outreach** (30 min-2 hours | individually arranged) – Fun and educational STEM activities with faculty. For elementary and middle schoolers. English.

Leadership Team (high-performing sophomores):

- **Field Trip/Retreat (August)** – social capital / community resources / bonding / budgeting / personality tests / personal values & goals – pre-figuring meeting with faculty
- **HOLA Festival Fundraiser (September)** – fundraiser / community connections
- **One-on-Ones with Faculty (September)** – academics / personal goals
- **Fall Outreach about post-secondary (various dates)** – leadership development / community resource
- **LT Check-In (November)** – review the semester. Plan Posada and discuss January goings-on.
- **Retreat/Life After WSCC Workshop (January)** - connect with alumni re. transfer / loans / plan / plan spring semester
- **Tamale Fundraiser (February)** – scholarship fund
- **Nashville Leadership Trip (February)** – community connections
- **One-on-Ones with Faculty (March)** – resume / transfer situation / faculty interview for reference
- **Spring Outreach about post-secondary (various dates)** – leadership development / community resource
- **LT Check-In (April)** – review the semester. Plan the End-of-Year Celebration and transfer situations.
- **LT Recruiting Meeting + End of Year Celebration + Alumni (May)** – certificates + conclusion + a social to invite new applicants
- **LT Interviews (May-Aug)** – Via Zoom or phone

For all RHiTA students:

- **Kickoff – Morristown (August before Prez's Picnic)** – belongingness + recruit involvement / campus tour?
- **RHiTA Rallies – all 3 campuses (Aug-Sep)** – Campus Connections + Meetings about classes/to socialize for first 2 weeks of the semester
- **RHiTA Rallies – all 3 campuses (Jan)** – Campus Connections + Meetings about classes/to socialize for first 2 weeks of the semester
- **LT Recruiting Meeting + End of Year Celebration + Alumni (May)** – certificates + conclusion + a social to invite new applicants
